

MEDICAL REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (Chapter 161)

PROMULGATION (NO. 3) OF THE MEDICAL COUNCIL OF HONG KONG
ON LIMITED REGISTRATION

G.N. 4516

Notice is hereby given that:-

1. Pursuant to section 14A of the Medical Registration Ordinance, Chapter 161 of the Laws of Hong Kong, ('the Ordinance'), the Medical Council of Hong Kong ('the Council') has determined that until such time as it may make a contrary determination the following employment is appropriate and necessary for limited registration for the purpose of the Ordinance :-

'Being such persons (whose names were entered prior to the end of 1964 into a list maintained by the Registrar of Clinics, Department of Health) appointed for the provision of primary healthcare, and to be responsible for the medical management of those clinics exempted from the provisions of section 7 of the Medical Clinics Ordinance, Chapter 343 of the Laws of Hong Kong'

2. Persons registered as medical practitioners with limited registration under this promulgation shall be subject to the following restrictions and conditions regarding their practice:-

- (1) the Professional Code and Conduct for the Guidance of Registered Medical Practitioners, published by the Council; and

- (2) The Code of Practice for Medical Practitioners Registered with Limited Registration in accordance with Promulgation (No. 3), published by the Council.

3. Persons wishing to be registered as medical practitioners with limited registration under this promulgation may obtain application forms and direct their enquiries to :-
