

Polling for 2020 Election of Medical Members of The Medical Council of Hong Kong

A Medical Council election is being conducted to fill 3 vacancies for elected Members of the Council under section 3(2)(j) of the Medical Registration Ordinance. The term of office of the elected Members will be for 3 years from 24 January 2021 to 23 January 2024.

Further to the notice of election dated 19 May 2020 issued to all qualified electors inviting nominations for the election, a total of 5 valid nominations have been received by the nomination closing date on 1 September 2020. As the number of validly nominated candidates exceeds the number of vacancies, a poll will be conducted to elect 3 Members to the Council.

The notice of result of nomination and the ballot paper have been issued to all qualified electors. The completed ballot paper must be returned to the Medical Council Secretariat by post on or before 3 December 2020 (i.e. the closing date of polling). Ballot papers postmarked after the closing date of polling will be rejected. Given the possible delay in both local and international postal services as a consequence of the current COVID-19 epidemic, please send the completed ballot paper as early as possible to ensure that they can reach the Medical Council Secretariat in time. For ballot papers posted from outside Hong Kong, they should be returned by airmail.

Vote counting for the election will be conducted on 30 December 2020.
